For 4th-12th Grades and Community Audiences

Jalala Paul Taylor introduces his audiences to the "The Dreaming" and shares stories, songs, bird calls and ancient wisdom from the "Bush University," his adopted Wardaman Aboriginal heritage; includes Aboriginal teachings of caring, inclusion, social and environmental justice in these uncertain times.

The wisdom of these stories applies universally and the show can adapt to all age levels, enhanced with live artist illumination. There is a break between segments for teachers/presenters to pause if desired for active artist commentary and audience discussion. The show video runs 30-40 mins. Program runs 45-60' with artist interaction.
